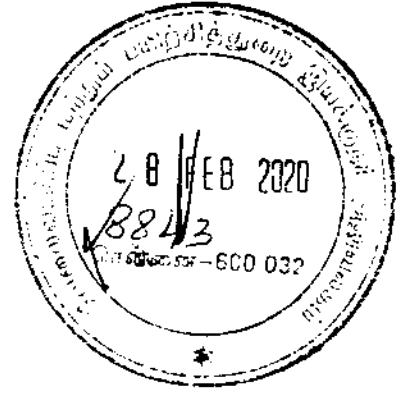

ORDER:

During the Assembly Session 2019-2020, the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu made the following announcement under Rule 110 in the floor of Assembly on 12.07.2019 :-

“இளைஞர்கள் வேலைவாய்ப்பு அதிகமுள்ள தொழிற்பிரிவுகளில் பயிற்சி பெற ஏதுவாக, அம்பத்தூர், செங்கல்பட்டு, திருச்சிராப்பள்ளி, கடலூர், பெரம்பலூர், கோயம்புத்தூர், சேலம், திண்டுக்கல், மதுரை, விருதுநகர், தூத்துக்குடி ஆகிய 11 அரசு தொழிற்பயிற்சி நிலையங்களில் நீண்ட கால மற்றும் குறுகிய கால புதிய தொழிற்பிரிவுகள் 44.19 கோடி ரூபாய் செலவில் தொடங்கப்படும்.”

2. In the letter fourth read above, the Director of Employment and Training has stated that,

(i) The funds announced to be sanctioned in the above announcement was Rs.44.19 Crore, which included Rs.26.00 Crore as Central Share under the Skills

Strengthening for Industrial Value Enhancement (STRIVE) project and Rs.18.19 Crore as State Share.

(ii) Based on the above announcement, the Director of Employment and Training has sent a proposal vide letter third read above, to start new trades / new age courses / short term courses under STRIVE project in 11 Government ITIs.

(iii) In the Third Meeting of National Steering Committee of STRIVE - World Bank Assisted Scheme held on 4th November 2019 in MSDE, New Delhi, in point no. 5 – Critical challenges in available funding and fund flow to implementing agencies, it is informed that 'the project has been allocated Rs.61.72 Crore only. The unavailability of required funding is hindering the progress of implementation of the project by implementing agencies in the State.'

(iv) In the above circumstances, the Director of Employment and Training has sent an alternative proposal for utilising the State share of Rs.18.19 Crore for rationalisation of trades in the following categories in the existing Government ITIs to achieve the Key Performance Indicators as mentioned in the STRIVE scheme :-

3. The Commissioner of Employment and Training has sent the following proposal for Category 4 said above i.e., Upgrading 8 existing trade as per NSQF syllabus in 26 Government ITIs in the State :-

(i) The DGT had notified National Skills Qualifications Framework in 2013 and has made it mandatory for all training / educational programmes / courses to be NSQF-compliant. Under NSQF, the learner can acquire the certification for competency needed at any level through formal, non-formal or informal learning. Accordingly, the DGT had issued instructions vide the letter first read above, to implement the above mentioned NSQF compliant CTS courses with effect from August 2018 session.

(ii) As per the revised syllabus, training is being imparted in all the trades in the State from August 2018 session onwards. Accordingly, in the Government Order second read above, a sum of Rs.37.62 Crore was sanctioned for procurement of additional machinery, tools & equipment for 19 trades of 37 existing Government ITIs and Procurement process is under progress.

(iii) 8 more trades in 26 Government ITIs needs to be upgraded as per NSQF standards to impart training. Though training is being imparted with the existing infrastructure in these trades in the revised curricula, the infrastructure is yet to be upgraded. So, it becomes imperative on the part of the State Government to upgrade the syllabus of ITI courses and align all the ITI trades as per NSQF, so as to retain the affiliation status and to obtain Government of India assistance for implementation of upcoming schemes.

4. Hence, the Director of Employment and Training has requested to permit to upgrade the existing 8 trades in 26 Government ITIs as per revised NCVT syllabus and sanction a sum of Rs.920.00 Lakh as non-recurring expenditure for procurement of additional machinery, tools and equipment as detailed in the table below :-
