ORDER:

In the letters read above, the Director of Employment and Training has proposed to replace the unpopular and low admission trades with demand driven trades in Government Industrial Training Institutes throughout the State as below:-

I. Unpopular trades

Trades such as Desk Top Publishing Operator, Digital Photography, Computer Hardware and Network Maintenance, Computer Operator cum Programming Assistant, Foundryman, Painter General, Tools & Die Maker and Sewing Technology have become unpopular among the youth in certain areas due to its long duration of training period. Whereas these courses are being imparted in a short span by many agencies / private concerns. So, it is proposed to convert these courses into demand driven trades / short term courses as required.

2. 3. The Director of Employment and Training has requested the Government to issue the following orders:-

- i. To permit to replace the trades with poor admission with demand driven trades in Government Industrial Training Institutes as detailed in para 2 above and to sanction a sum of Rs. 438.78 Lakh as non-recurring expenditure for procurement of machineries, tools and equipment.
- ii. To permit to utilize the existing posts wherever new trades have been started in the place of old trades.

- iii. To permit to utilize recurring cost towards raw materials as per G.O. (Ms.) No. 197, Labour and Employment Department, dated 17.10.2019.
- iv. To permit to make admission in new trades from August 2020 session onwards.

4. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Director of Employment and Training and accordingly issue the following orders :-

- i. Permission is accorded to the Director of Employment and Training to replace the trades with poor admission with demand driven trades in Government ITIs as detailed in para 2 above and sanction is also accorded for a sum of Rs.4,38,78,000/- (Rupees Four crore thirty eight lakh seventy eight thousand only) as non-recurring expenditure towards procurement of machineries, tools and equipment for introduction of these demand driven trades.
- ii. Permission is also accorded to the Director of Employment and Training to utilize the existing posts wherever new trades have been started in the place of old trades.
- iii. Permission is also accorded to the Director of Employment and Training to utilize recurring cost towards raw materials as per G.O. (Ms.) No. 197, Labour and Employment Department, dated 17.10.2019.
- iv. Permission is also accorded to the Director of Employment and Training to make admission in new trades from August 2020 session onwards.

5. The expenditure sanctioned at para 4(i) above shall be debitible in the following head of account:-

4250 – 00 – Capital Outlay on other Social Service – 203 Employment – State's Expenditure – JG Development of Industrial Training Institute Land and Buildings – 419 Machinery and Equipments – 01 Purchase.
