ORDER:

During the Budget session 2014-15, the Hon'ble Minister for Labour has made the following announcement in the floor of the House on 11.07.2014.

“To meet the industrial needs, more employable trades like Welder, Electrician, Wireman, A/c Mechanic trades will be started additionally in 12 existing Government Industrial Training Institutes at an expenditure of Rs. 10.86 crore”

2. In the letter read above, the Director of Employment and Training has submitted the proposal to start 15 new trades in 12 Government Industrial Training Institutes as detailed below:

3. Hence, the Director of Employment and Training has requested to issue orders on the following points:-

1. Permission to start the 15 new trades in 12 Government Industrial Training Institutes under State Council for Vocational Training pattern initially with effect from August 2015 and then to switch over the courses under National Council for Vocational Training pattern after getting affiliation from National Council for Vocational Training.
2. To sanction the required number of instructors (Junior Training Officers / Assistant Training Officers) for each course in each Government Industrial Training Institute. (15x2 = 30 Posts)
3. To sanction an amount of Rs.1086.67 lakh towards expenditure on Civil Works, Machineries and Equipments, Furniture, Affiliation fee and other administrative charges including staff salary.
4. The Government have carefully examined the proposal of the Director of Employment and Training and issue the following orders:

1. Permission is accorded to start the 15 new trades in 12 Government Industrial Training Institutes as in annexure -I to this order, under State Council for Vocational Training pattern initially with effect from August 2015 and then to switch over the courses under National Council for Vocational Training pattern after getting affiliation from National Council for Vocational Training.
2. Sanction is accorded for creation of 15 posts of Assistant Training Officers and 15 post of Junior Training Officers (Total 15+15 = 30) (2 instructors for each trade) on consolidated pay of Rs.10,000/- per month.
3. Administrative sanction is accorded for an amount of Rs.1036.41 lakh (Rupees Ten crore thirty six lakh and forty one thousand only) and financial sanction is accorded for Rs.515.35 lakhs (Rupees five crores fifteen lakhs and thirty five thousand only) as detailed in the annexure - II to this order.
5. The administration sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.521.06 lakh towards civil works and financial sanction will be accorded on furnishing of the abstract for the estimates for all Government Industrial Training Institutes by the Director of Employment and Training.
6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following Head of Accounts:-

The Director of Employment and Training is also directed to send necessary draft explanatory note to Government in Finance department for

inclusion of this expenditure in the supplementary estimates for the year 2014 - 2015 to Government without fail.
